

## BSB UNIFORM GUIDELINES & DRESS CODE

BSB school and PE uniforms are **mandatory** for all students in Pre-Nursery (BSB Sitges campus only), Early Years, Primary and Secondary.

### MANDATORY ITEMS

#### Pre-Nursery (BSB Sitges Campus only) & Early Years

- BSB Polo
- BSB Shorts
- BSB Sweatshirt
- BSB Tracksuit bottoms
- BSB Smock (we recommend 2)
- BSB Cap (part of our sun protection policy and for security on school excursions)
- Red socks or tights (please see [website](#) for examples of colour)
- Dark coloured shoes/trainers (please see [website](#) for examples)
- Hair accessories in the BSB colours only (suggested examples [online](#))

#### Primary

- BSB Polo
- BSB Jumper or Cardigan
- BSB Trousers, Shorts, Skirt or Culottes
- BSB PE T-shirt
- BSB PE shorts or leggings
- BSB PE Tracksuit jacket
- BSB Tracksuit bottoms
- BSB Cap (part of our sun protection policy and for security on school excursions)
- BSB Swimming shorts or costume
- Black school shoes (please see [website](#) for examples)
- A pair of either all black or all white trainers for PE
- One set of stud earrings only. No jewellery for PE.
- Plain grey or black socks or tights (please see [website](#) for examples of grey colour)
- Hair accessories in the BSB colours only (suggested examples [online](#))

**Please note that only current uniform should be used (except for the PE T-shirt for Secondary Castelldefels).**

**\* Note regarding Secondary PE T-Shirt House colours**

From September 2023 there will be House PE T-shirts in Secondary, with a different colour for each of the Houses.

There are 6 Houses in Castelldefels Secondary (Abbey – white, Baker – red, Carnaby – orange, Downing – green, Electric – yellow, Fleet – blue).

There are 4 Houses in City Secondary (Baker – red, Downing – green, Electric – yellow, Fleet – blue)

Students and families have been informed of their House.

The new PE T-shirts are already available on the uniform supplier's website. The old white PE T-shirts are now no longer available to buy.

In Castelldefels Secondary there will be a 2-year phasing out period for the old white PE T-shirts. All students should have the new shirt by September 2025.



## SHOES

Students in Primary and Secondary **must** purchase a pair of **black school shoes** to wear with their uniform. This can include **all-black** training shoes.

Our uniform supplier has a range of shoes available to buy online or in store, should you struggle to find similar ones elsewhere. They also sell the correct colour of socks and tights.

## OPTIONAL ITEMS

- BSB Coat | BSB Fleece | BSB Waterproof | BSB Rucksack | BSB Gilet | Summer dress (Primary)

It is not necessary to purchase all of the optional items. However, for Primary and Secondary should you purchase an alternative coat that is not BSB, please ensure this is either dark/navy blue or black. Hooded jumpers are not permitted as a coat alternative.

## Summer Period:

The physical shop will be closed from the 29th of July 2023 to the 17th of August 2023 (inclusive).

**Note:** From the 18th of August 2023 to the 15th of September 2023 the physical shop will be open Monday to Friday from 9.00 – 19.00 and will not close at lunch time. It will also be open on Saturdays from 10.00 – 14.00.

## Orders over the Summer Period:

The supplier strongly recommends making online **orders before the 20 July 2023** to ensure delivery for September. If you wish to go to the physical shop to buy uniform, due to the limited amount of people allowed inside the shop area, they recommend arranging an appointment in advance via the calendar on their website.

## DRESS CODE FOR PRE-UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (YEARS 12 & 13)

### Acceptable wear

Clothing should be suitable for a university or office environment. There is no uniform in Nexus, but we do ask students to dress for a semi-formal work environment. As such, we request that they do not wear the following:

- Ripped jeans
- Crop tops (i.e., tops cut to expose stomachs)
- Flip flops
- Short shorts
- Hats/hoods when inside (hoodies are allowed)
- Tops with offensive logos/slogans

We hope this dress code allows students to express themselves as the individuals that they are whilst also respecting the expectations of our community.
