An essential criterion for this role is a proven track record in teaching Chemistry, at GCSE and IBDP or A level standards. An ability to teach KS3 Science as well as another area of the IGCSE Double Award Science would be an advantage.

We offer a comprehensive range of examinations including IGCSE and IBDP courses in the sciences. An individual adept at inspiring students to excel in scientific pursuits, both within and beyond the classroom, would be an invaluable addition to our faculty.
