

## **BSB UNIFORM GUIDELINES & DRESS CODE**

BSB school and PE uniforms are **mandatory** for all students in Pre-Nursery (BSB Sitges campus only), Early Years, Primary and Secondary. Please ensure that all uniform items are clearly marked with the student's full name.

## **MANDATORY ITEMS**

# Pre-Nursery (BSB Sitges campus only) & Early Years

- BSB Polo
- BSB Shorts
- BSB Sweatshirt
- BSB Tracksuit bottoms
- BSB Smock (we recommend 2)
- Cap (part of our sun protection policy and for security on school excursions)
- Red socks or tights (please see <u>website</u> for examples of colour)
- Sensible plain trainers or shoes (please see website for examples)
- Hair accessories in the BSB colours only (suggested examples <u>online</u>)

## **Primary**

- BSB Polo
- BSB Jumper or Cardigan
- BSB Trousers, Shorts, Skirt or Culottes
- BSB PE T-shirt
- BSB PE shorts or leggings
- BSB PE Tracksuit jacket
- BSB Tracksuit bottoms
- Cap (part of our sun protection policy and for security on school excursions)
- Swimming shorts or costume
- Sensible black school shoes (please see website for examples)
- A pair of trainers for PE
- One set of stud earrings only. No jewellery for PE
- Plain grey or black socks or tights (please see website for examples of grey colour)
- Hair accessories in the BSB colours only (suggested examples online)

# Secondary

- BSB Shirt
- BSB Jumper or Cardigan
- BSB Trousers, Shorts\*, Skirt\* (shorts/skirts to be no shorter than mid-thigh length)
- BSB PE T-shirt (in House colour see note below)
- BSB PE leggings or tracksuit bottoms. BSB skort or shorts\*
- BSB PE Tracksuit jacket
- Cap (part of our sun protection policy)
- Sensible black school shoes (please see <u>website</u> for examples). No boots or shoes over the ankle
- A separate pair of trainers for PE

- Long white socks and shin pads for PE
- Gum shield for PE
- Plain grey or black ankle socks or tights (please see <u>website</u> for examples of grey colour)
- Jewellery: one set of stud earrings only, worn in the lower earlobe. No other piercings allowed. Maximum of one bracelet, one necklace (not a choker), one ring. No jewellery worn during PE
- Any visible tattoos should be covered
- Nails should be kept short to minimise risk in PE and other activities. Only neutralcoloured nails are permitted

Note: If any specific equipment is required for sporting activities (such as multi-taco boots), this will be communicated directly by the PE department.

<sup>\*</sup>Please do not shorten the length of these items of uniform.



## **Secondary PE T-Shirt House colours**

In Secondary there are House PE T-shirts, with a different colour for each of the Houses.

There are 6 Houses in Castelldefels Secondary (Abbey – white, Baker – red, Carnaby – orange, Downing – green, Electric – yellow, Fleet – blue).

There are 4 Houses in City Secondary (Baker – red, Downing – green, Electric – yellow, Fleet – blue)

Students and families have been informed of their House.

The old white PE T-shirts are no longer available to buy. In BSB Castelldefels and BSB City Secondary all students should have the new shirt by September 2025.



#### **SHOES**

Students in Primary and Secondary **must** purchase a pair of sensible **black school shoes** to wear with their uniform. This can include **all-black** training shoes.

Our uniform supplier has a range of shoes available to buy online or in store, should you struggle to find similar ones elsewhere. They also sell the correct colour of socks and tights.

#### **OPTIONAL ITEMS**

BSB Swimming shorts or costume (Primary) | BSB Cap | BSB Coat | BSB Fleece | BSB Waterproof |
BSB Rucksack | BSB Gilet | BSB Summer dress (Primary)

It is not necessary to purchase all of the optional items. However, for Primary and Secondary should you purchase an alternative coat that is not BSB, please ensure this is either dark/navy blue or black. Hooded jumpers or zipped sweatshirts are not permitted as a coat alternative.

Monday to Friday, 8.30-13.30 and 16.00-19.00 (Saturday and Sunday closed)

**Advance appointments:** If you wish to go to the physical shop to buy a uniform, due to the limited amount of people allowed inside the shop, the uniform supplier recommends arranging an appointment in advance via the calendar on their website.

#### **Summer Period:**

The physical shop will be closed from 1st August 2025 to 19th August 2025 (both included).

**Note:** From 20th August 2025 to 12th September 2025, the physical shop will be open Monday to Friday from 9.00 - 19.00 and will not close at lunch time. It will also be open on Saturday 23rd August 2025 and Saturday 30th 2025 from 10.00 - 14.00.

#### Orders over the Summer Period:

The supplier strongly recommends making online **orders before 20th July 2025** to ensure delivery for September. If you wish to go to the physical shop to buy uniform, due to the limited amount of people allowed inside the shop area, they recommend arranging an appointment in advance via the calendar on their website.

# DRESS CODE FOR PRE-UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (YEARS 12 & 13)

## Acceptable wear

Clothing should be suitable for a university or office environment. There is no uniform in Nexus, but we do ask students to dress for a semi-formal work environment. As such, we request that they do not wear the following:

- Ripped jeans
- Crop tops (i.e., tops cut to expose stomachs)
- Flip flops

- Shorts and skirts shorter than mid-thigh
- Hats/hoods when inside (hoodies are allowed)
- Tops with offensive logos/slogans

We hope this dress code allows students to express themselves as the individuals that they are whilst also respecting the expectations of our community.

Important note: all Year 12 and Year 13 students are expected to wear a security lanyard at all times when in the school sites.
